Submitting work is free and open to women of all ages. Anonymous and non-English work is accepted.

These locations may include the Mission, Womenspace, prisons, White Bird Clinic, Ophelia's Place and Centro Latino.

The Pluma Project is volunteer-run and is working with Womenspace, SASS, the University of Oregon's Women's Center, and the Sexual Assault Task Force. Its goal is to encourage women to share their experiences with all types of violence in order to create unity, strength and a sense of community among survivors.
